Dear Parents/Carers,

Below is costume information for this year's summer production of Wind in the Willows. We would really appreciate your help with creating costumes for your children and have done our best to make them as simple and flexible as possible. Some of the KS2 children may want headwear to go with their costume but please make sure their faces are visible for singing and delivering lines clearly. We will also have a wonderful team of parents, kindly lead by Lucy Cassidy, who will be supporting the school with face paints for the shows. If you have any questions about your child's costume, need clarification or are finding it difficult to source please contact a member of the staff team. Please bring all costumes to school in named bags before the week beginning Monday 7th July.

Reception and Little Lambs will play the parts of ducks. Appropriate headdresses will be created in school. In terms of clothing it would be wonderful if the children could be dressed as fully in white or yellow, as possible.

Year 1 and 2 will be rabbits. They will be creating bunny ears on elastic headbands as part of their sewing DT project which will be brown. Could you also please provide clothing which is suitably rabbit coloured eg all in brown, grey, white etc

Below are some suggestions for KS2 parts however for many of these please use your own judgement about what would be suitable and ask specifically if you are uncertain. If your child has more than one role we apologise for a more complicated wardrobe request and hope you are able to work with simple costumes and some items which may be used for multiple costumes.

River People – floaty, summery clothing such as dresses and billowing material in shades of blue.

Stage Crew – black top and black trousers.

Narrators – the narrators would like to be different elements. Mya will be fire, Sylvie water, Elva earth, Nola air and Ada forest. Can they please wear suitable colours for these with any decoration that is suitable.



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Weasels, stoats, Harry and Bert – tops and trousers in shades of brown (dark brown if possible).

Lemonade stand man – shirt and trousers of your choice but not too modern if possible. A name badge and flat cap might be nice.

Ethel – ideally a black, long sleeved top with a long white skirt or a black dress with a white apron.

Jeeves – ideally black trousers, a white shirt and a black jacket.

Sally – long sleeved top, long white skirt or apron.

Train Drivers – blue or black jacket, blue or white shirt, blue trousers or dungarees or boiler suit.

Rupert (terribly upper class) – trousers, jacket, shirt, hat

Monica (terribly upper class) – long summer dress and hat

Policemen – blue jacket and trousers, police helmet if possible

Clerk (singing part) – black and white clothing

Chairman of the Board of Magistrates – black and white clothing, wig and/or ruff if possible but this is a singing part only.

Delivery Man – trousers, shirt and jacket or dungarees or boiler suits, maybe a flat cap if possible.

Salesman – trousers, shirt, jacket

Prisoners – black and white stripy tops or white shirt, dark trousers and jacket and flat cap if possible.
