Dear Parents & Carers,

The whole school (Reception to year 6) are going on a trip on **Friday 13th June** (next week) to the SS Great Britain, as part of our theme 'All Aboard'. You can access the website here for more information: [Home - SS Great Britain](#). Little Lambs will remain at school on this day.

As usual when we do a whole school trip, the coach will leave from, and return to, Stratford Park Leisure Centre.

Children need to be at Stratford Park Leisure Centre for 8.40 a.m at the latest as the coach will be leaving shortly after. Staff will be there to meet children from 8.20 a.m if you need an early drop off.

The coach will be back at Stratford Park for 3.15 p.m all being well, as we are due to leave the SS Great Britain by 2.15 p.m. We will keep you updated by text message in the afternoon.

Please read the following information carefully:

All children will need to bring with them a packed lunch, morning and afternoon snack and drink as this is an all-day event. They will need to be able to carry their bag so please pack lightly – for example lunch boxes can be heavy so you might want to wrap lunches in a different way for this day. We can refill water bottles whilst there. Children should wear school uniform and should bring or wear a waterproof coat/sun hat depending on the weather on the day. They may like to bring a book or small game for the coach (nothing electronic please). Please let us know if your child may get travel sick so we can sit them nearer the front.

Children will move around the SS Great Britain site with their class or year group and will also take part in a workshop during the day.

FOSS have kindly agreed to cover a significant proportion of the cost for this trip which we greatly appreciate. The cost of the trip is £12.00 per child, which can be paid via ParentPay before the end of the school year. If you have any questions please do get in touch.
