Whole School Trip - St Fagans National Museum of History, Cardiff.

We are very excited to let you know that next week on **Tuesday 18th March** the whole school will be going to **St Fagans National Museum of History, Cardiff** to support the learning this term connected with our whole school theme 'Grand Deigns' looking at houses through the ages in Britain.

If you haven't been before St Fagans National Museum of History is an open-air museum where visitors can explore over forty carefully reconstructed buildings from different periods of history from across Wales. As part of this trip, each year group will also take part in a workshop during the day.
