We really encourage the children to explore additional reading material that aligns with their interests at home.

We will give out spellings every Friday, which will be tested the following week. Each child has been provided with a yellow book where the spellings will be stuck in. We kindly ask that these books are returned to school each Friday.

Additionally, Forest School sessions will be held every other Thursday afternoon starting next week at Ebworth. As we all know that the weather can be quite unpredictable, suitable clothing including trousers, Long-sleeved top, waterproof coat and appropriate footwear (wellies/walking boots) are essential.

Children should have a water bottle in school each day and can bring a healthy snack to eat at breaktime.

This term, our topic is "One Small Step", focusing on space exploration and flight.
