Both trips are happening on the same day. **The coaches for each trip will leave from, and return to, Stratford Park Leisure Centre** on this day. Children need to be at Stratford Park for 8.45 a.m at the latest. Staff will be there to meet children from 8.30 a.m. If you need an earlier drop for work reasons Mr Crocker and Mr Dangerfield will be there from 8.20 a.m.

The coach will be back at Stratford Park for 3.15 p.m all being well, as we are due to leave each farm by 2.00 p.m. We will keep you updated by text message in the afternoon.

Please read the following information carefully:

For the Cotswold Farm Park trip (Merlin Class)- children will need to bring with them a packed lunch, morning and afternoon snack and drink as this is an all-day event. Children must also bring or wear a waterproof coat as most of the day is outdoors.

For the Sandfield Farm trip (Eagle /Kestrel Classes) children will need to bring with them a packed lunch, morning and afternoon snack and drink as this is an all-day event. Children must wear clothes that can get muddy, long sleeves, long trousers and wellies and if possible should bring waterproof trousers. The farm leaders say that wellies are required even in warm weather. A hat is also a good idea. Children should also bring a change of clothes including socks. Children will be outside for most of the day.
